Anna Mae Glidewell, 83 of Anadarko, Oklahoma was called home by the Lord on Monday, July 2, 2012 at her home, with her family by her side. She was a special education teacher at Purnell from 1970 through 1972 and at Anadarko Middle School from 1972 until her retirement in May 1990. In 1989 she was selected as teacher of the year at the Anadarko Junior High School. Her talents were many but she especially enjoyed sewing, crocheting and quilting. Among other things, she made recital, prom and wedding dresses as well as costumes for school programs for her children and grandchildren. In addition each of her children and grandchildren have afghans and quilts made by her to cherish for many years to come. She was a member of the Anadarko Philomathic Club.
