April 15, 1931 - June 6, 2020

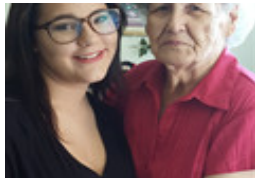
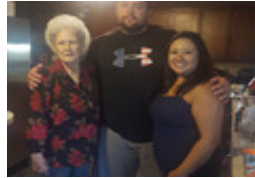
