She also loved bowling, taking a cruise on Wrandall's motorcycle, reading books, watching her scary shows and other movies. Her employment included Four Tribes JTPA/TERO, Sonya's Drive-Thru, Wichita Tribe Princess director for several years, Homemaker, Caregiver, and uncertified Family Mountain Doctor.
