



## Flora Belle Schrock

January 6, 1919 - April 24, 2018

Flora Belle Schrock age 99, the oldest Kiowa woman, passed away peacefully in Chickasha, Oklahoma on April 24, 2018. She was full blooded Kiowa, known as Thi-gai chan mah (She arrives safely) born to Guy Tainpeah and Blanche Lucy Jackson January 6, 1919 in Anadarko, Oklahoma. She graduated from St. Patrick's Catholic School and she met and married Harry Schrock and during WWII Flora Belle went to Tinker Air Force Base and riveted airplane parts together. After WWII she went to work at Riverside Indian School. Then they moved to Albuquerque, NM spending several years there and moved on to Chinle, AZ where she began her career working for the BIA. She also liked beadworking making different things. Retiring in the 70's she began traveling across the U.S. to Pow Wow's and Art's and Craft shows. Flora Belle was also a member of St. Patricks Catholic Church. She is survived by 7 Grandchildren: Glen, Duane, Ann, Vonnie, Luke, Lee and Arthur, 25 Great Grandchildren and 27 Great Great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband Harry, Daughter Glenna, Son Gerald, Grandson Jack and Great Grandson Kootz. There will be a rosary service at Smiths Funeral Home Friday April 27, 2018 at 7pm. Funeral services will be held at St. Patrick's Catholic Church Saturday April 28th, 2018 at 10 AM with burial to follow at Memory Lane Cemetery. There will be a reception to follow at St. Patricks Church.
