Haden Paul Gregory, 90, of Anadarko, Oklahoma was called home by the Lord on Monday, January 20, 2014, at his home while surrounded by his family. Born in Comanche County Texas to Wesley Cleburn Gregory and Nellie Carol Barbee on February 27, 1923. He attended a one room school house in Comanche County and was known as an accomplished fiddle player during his youth. Later Paul served in the U.S. Army as a Staff Sergeant, stationed in Alaska, from 1943-1946. Paul married Louise Thompson in 1958 and together they raised eight children. Paul worked in construction and moved with his family to Anadarko in 1965. He built the first ten homes in Regency Addition, the Regency Apartments, and Sinclair Service Station. He owned and operated Gregory Millwork up until 1985 when his sons took over the business. After retiring from the cabinet shop, Paul and Louise operated Beaver Express Freight Company. Paul enjoyed fishing, gardening, playing dominoes, and spending time with his family. He especially enjoyed attending annual family reunions at Lake Texoma and often said his greatest asset in life was his children. He will be greatly missed by all of those whose lives he has touched.
