Iris June "Whitey" Wetselline Walker, 69, of Anadarko, Oklahoma, passed away on Friday, June 14, 2013 at her home in Anadarko. She played softball and basketball and was an avid fan and cheerleader of the Fort Cobb Broxton Mustangs. Iris was one of the few full blood Apache Tribal members left.
