He graduated from East Central University with a Bachelor of Education and later attended Oklahoma City University and completed a Masters Degree. Jon was equally passionate about his teaching career as well as his artwork. His friends described him as a concerned citizen regarding public education and the effects of decisions made with regard to public education. Jon is multi-talented, a great speaker, a people-person, intelligent, and hard-working.

He cared deeply for his family and friends and will be dearly missed by many, including, his son's Forrest and Ryan Belindo and his daughter Allison Benton.
