She was a KBC member and also twice elected secretary, IHS union leader for the dental department, leased Kiowa Kettle for a number of years. Kathleen bought and sold Native American goods and sold them in three different states with her son and close friend. She did art and bead work, loved to cook, ran the Kiowa snack bar and owned and operated her own antique shop. Kathleen was very easy going, loved to joke and everybody loved being around her. She was a member of Indian Caddo Baptist Church. Kathleen will be greatly missed by all who knew and loved her.
