Kittie Corinne (Spotts) Eads, age 93, of Ft Cobb, Oklahoma passed away peacefully Wednesday, October 21, 2020 after a brief stay in hospice at Mercy Hospital, OKC, OK with her daughter by her side, playing her favorite hymns to her as she left this Earth. Kittie was born on December 16, 1926 in Haskell, Oklahoma to William and Florence (Lent) Spotts. She loved and was loved by all her family and friends and had open arms to anyone that came to visit. Her greatest joys were feeding everyone and having her family together and she kept herself busy in retirement with cooking, quilting, sewing, needlepoint, crocheting, and teaching her grandchildren how to sew, crochet, cook, make pickled quail eggs, and possum grape jelly. Kittie was preceded in death by her husband of 67 years, Earl Warren Eads, a daughter, Eva Sue Silva, grandson Jess Andrew Eads, son in law, Ronald DeBaun, and her brothers and sisters and their spouses, Lois and Gould Lebrecht, Hazel Spotts, Nick Spotts, Donald and Gladys Spotts, Dwight and Arta Sue Spotts, Kenneth and

Minnie Spotts, and Gerald and Nina Spotts. Kittie is survived by three daughters, Mary Silva, Carol Debaun, Lisa (and spouse Jon) Green; two sons, Warren (and spouse Lee) Eads, Wayne (and spouse Patsy) Eads and numerous grandchildren and great-grandchildren and one great-great-grandson and many others who called her Grandma.
