Marcella Stockton was born on May 12, 1926, in Gracemont, Oklahoma, to Arther and Linnie (Bost) Morgan. She passed from this life on June 15, 2024.

Marcella was united in marriage to Austin E. Stockton on July 6, 1949, in the Fort Cobb First Baptist Church by Rev. Leroy Meyer. Austin passed away on August 17, 1994.

Marcella graduated from Fort Cobb High School in 1944; earned her Bachelor of Science in Education from Oklahoma College for Women in 1948; Master of Education from Southwestern State College in 1969. She was Business Education teacher at Fort Cobb High School from 1948-1964. Marcella and Austin then moved to Durango, Colorado, where she taught Vocational Business Education for 20 years, from 1964-1984. After their retirement in 1984, Austin and Marcella returned to their original home in Fort Cobb, built by Austin in 1957.
