She was also a foster parent for many years including the Caddo County Indian Children Foster program. Marjorie was a wonderful, faithful, generous, caring lady and had so much love to give not only to her foster children but also to her own family. She loved to cook, be involved with the church ladies sewing and quilting, to be with her family and enjoyed going to Pow Wows and watching the Black Leggings perform.
