William (Bill) Jackson Lewis, 82, of Anadarko, Oklahoma, went home to be with the Lord on Saturday, May 9, 2015 in Chickasha, Oklahoma. Bill was born March 31, 1933 in Anadarko to John Lewis and Ethel Young Lewis. He married Pauline Pierson on December 24, 1953 in Anadarko and left the following week to begin his service with the U.S. Army where he served in Germany during the Korean War. When he returned from the war he received training in electronics, then began his career as a television and small appliance repairman for Roberds and Wall TV and Appliance. He and business partner, Fred Hamilton, later bought the business and it became Hamilton-Lewis TV and Appliance. They owned the business until Bill's retirement. A lifelong resident of Anadarko, he and Pauline settled and raised their family north of town. His greatest past time was Anadarko Warrior Wrestling, baseball and watching his kids and grand kids participate in sports.
