Myrtle Dell Watson, 84, passed away in the early hours of the morning September 22, 2023 at Glenhaven Retirement Center in Chickasha. Myrtle was born April 29, 1939 to Ida and Henry Zigler in Anadarko, OK. She had one sibling, an older sister, Norma Jean, with whom she shared a close and loving relationship. She grew up on a farm outside of Cement, where she lived until she married Bill George Watson, Sr. on October 20, 1956. The couple then lived the rest of their lives in Anadarko, working and raising their four children.
