



Qunique Kawaykla

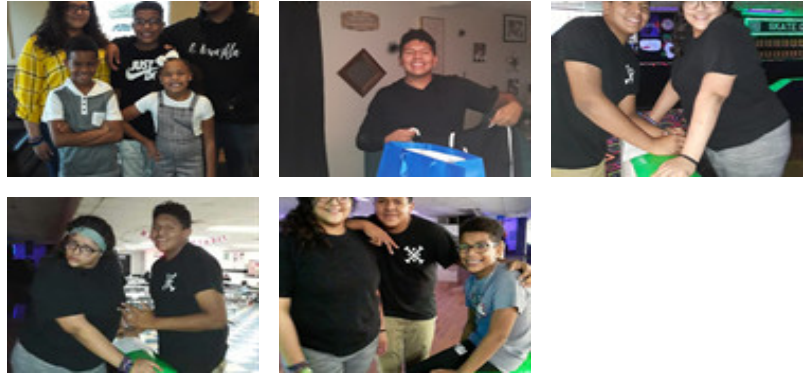
December 9, 2002 - March 16, 2020
