Richard Lee McGlothlin, 82, of Anadarko, Oklahoma, passed away on April 1, 2026. He was born on August 30, 1943, in Gracemont, Oklahoma to Allen McGlothlin and Geneva Gudgel McGlothlin. He was the youngest of 3 brothers.

On June 15, 1962, Richard married Reba Jean Allison. Together they made their home in Gracemont, Oklahoma, where they raised their 2 sons, Richie and Rodney. Richard was a member of Gracemont First Baptist Church and spent his recent years attending Anadarko First Baptist Church.

Richard worked at Jenkins Furniture for five years, then for some years as a truck driver for PSO. He then worked at Wag-a-Bag and Step-N-Fetch while he put himself through barber school, after which he opened and ran a barber shop in Gracemont. He also worked at the carpet mill, Hollytex, and Maremont/Gabriel where he retired from. Upon retirement he and Reba traveled the Bluegrass music circuit where he sang and played guitar with different bands and emcee'd bluegrass festivals. They then settled in Anadarko where they spent their time spoiling every one of their grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

Richard loved his grandchildren and great-grandchildren – they were some of his biggest blessings. He loved being Pops.

Richard is survived by his wife, Reba. His son Richie McGlothlin and wife Kelley, of Anadarko. His son Rodney McGlothlin and wife Bridgette, of

Gracemont. His grandson Shane McGlothlin and wife Jill, of Carnegie. His granddaughter Sheyanne Dirickson and husband Seth, of Gracemont. His great-grandchildren Barrett, Kanyon, Carsyn, and Waverly. As well as numerous nephews, nieces, cousins, and friends.
