February 3, 1921 - October 14, 2016

Romona Bradford was born February 3, 1921 in Caddo County, Oklahoma to Oscar Peter and Idabell (Harris) Bradford. She passed away on October 14, 2016 in Lawton, Oklahoma. Romona graduated from Cement High School in 1940, and then on to business school. She worked for the Office of Price Administration (OPA) during World War II, then the Air Force in Materiel at Tinker Field in Midwest City. She continued with the Air Force, moving to Topeka, St. Louis, and Harrisburg Pennsylvania, and finally to Kelly Air Force Base in San Antonio, Texas in 1966. She retired in 1978. She lived in San Antonio for 36 years, then moved to Lawton, Oklahoma. Romona is preceded in death by her father in 1970, mother in 1977, brothers: Winston in 1967 and Wilber in 2000.
