



## Ronald Phillip "Phil" Bassett

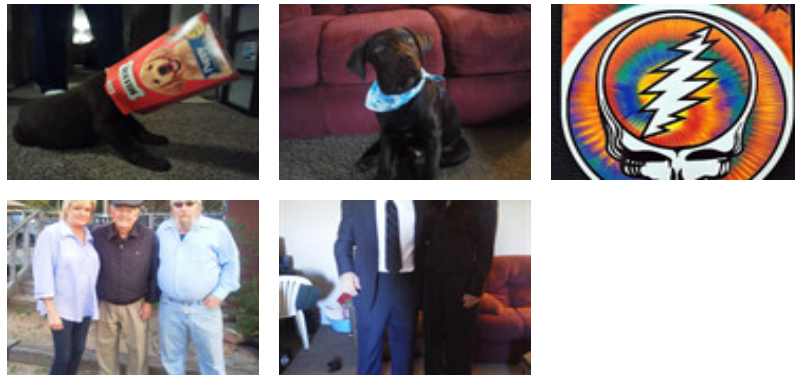
April 26, 1961 - July 31, 2016
