Royce Leo Madison Jr., 71, of Blanchard, Oklahoma, passed away February 11, 2026, in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

Royce was born December 20, 1954, at Fort Campbell to Royce Leo Madison Sr. and Yoko (Hotta) Madison. He proudly served in the United States Army from 1972 to 1975 and later worked in the oil field, where he was known for his strong work ethic and determination.

Royce had a fondness for odd numbers and was the proud father of three daughters from marriages #1, #3, and #5. His final marriage was with Jeanette Ahtone Madison on December 11, 1989 to her passing on June 9th, 2005. Following her passing, he declared five marriages were more than enough.
