Stephen Crowley Evans, was born in Anadarko, Oklahoma January 9, 1951 to Crowley and Wanda Smith Evans and passed away from this life July 25, 2025. He passed away peacefully surrounded by family.

Steve was a lifetime resident of Anadarko, where he graduated Anadarko High School in 1969. He worked with his parents at the Texaco refinery, hauling gasoline to neighboring towns. He married Peggy Jo Peppers, on October 17, 1968 in Wichita Falls, Texas.

He and his wife Peggy opened Ma and Pa's General Store in the mid-1970s, and loved interacting with all the customers and school kids who came in at lunch. Steve taught many local youth, men and women who have gone on to open their own schools.
